



BRAINERD HOMECOMING PARADE

It is time to make plans for your participation in the Brainerd Homecoming Parade. The Parade is coordinated by Brainerd Community Action, a non-profit corporation. Brainerd Community Action intends the parade to be a family event suitable for children of all ages. To ensure a successful parade and celebration, the Homecoming Committee has adopted the following rules:

- 1) The parade is limited to 75 units. Participation will be denied to units registering after 75 units have been registered.
- 2) The maximum length of each unit is 100 feet, with the exception of high school bands, fire truck, and special units.
- 3) To be registered on the parade roster, all parade units must sign and return the attached "Waiver Agreement," complete and return the entry form, and pay a fee (if applicable).
- 4) Parade entries will be accepted beginning August 14, 2009 until September 24, 2009. The **ABSOLUTE DEADLINE for completed parade entries will be September 24, 2009 at 5:00pm in the office of Brainerd Community Action.** Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Any notice of denial will be sent within ten working days of receipt, or within three days after the close of the deadline if received after September 24, 2009 and will occur for reasons stated in a written denial notice, which are consistent with the criteria set forth herein.
- 5) **CANDY AND OTHER ITEMS MAY NOT BE THROWN FROM ANY VEHICLES OR FLOATS AT ANY TIME DURING THE PARADE.**
- 6) All commercial units must pay a \$100 entry fee. The fee may be waived under the following circumstances:
 - A) If a donation of equal or greater amount is made to the Homecoming Celebration, 213 South Fifth Street, Brainerd, Minnesota 56401.
 - B) If you agree to sponsor a non-profit group or organization in the parade.
- 7) Any political office holder or candidate for a political office must pay a \$100 entrance fee, with the exception of parade dignitaries.

8) Each horse unit is required to provide for “ROAD APPLE CLEANUP”.

9) The parade will be open to expressions of support for political candidates, or public issues under the following guidelines:

A) Political officeholders or candidates for political office may participate in the parade, subject only to the content-neutral restrictions described in paragraph ten below.

B) Applicants who seek either to express support for political parties or candidates for office or to express opinions on public or political issues may participate in the parade, subject to the content-neutral restrictions described in paragraph ten below.

10) All parade participants shall conduct themselves in a manner appropriate for a family audience of all ages, march in a peaceful and orderly fashion, and participate in a civil manner with respect to other participants and the public. Parade participants shall not use obscenity, profanity, defamation, threats, or fighting words.

The Homecoming Parade will begin at 10:30am. A letter of confirmation, route map, directions to access the staging area, the location of water stations and restrooms on the parade route, and the schedule will be sent to you. Before your entry may be registered, the attached forms must be filled out **completely** and returned to the Brainerd Community Action office.

WAIVER AGREEMENT FOR RELEASE CLAIMS

BRAINERD HOMECOMING

We hereby release and discharge the Homecoming Celebration committee and Brainerd Community Action Inc. The release includes all claims that I or my child may have or which my child's heirs, executors, or assigns may have against the Committee or the cities for all personal and property injuries caused by or arising out of participation in the Homecoming Parade.

I have read this release and understand all of its terms. I acknowledge the inherent dangers involved in riding on a float, walking in the parade, riding a horse in the parade or riding a vehicle in the parade, including the dangers created by falling off a moving vehicle or horse, other motor vehicle traffic, street conditions and other participants. I voluntarily execute this release. I understand and agree that no one will be able to hold the above named parties liable for any injuries to my child or me.
